



Soccer 5v5 Competition Registration Terms & Conditions

Centennial Parklands Sports Centre is managed by Clublinks Management Pty Ltd (Clublinks) under a management agreement with the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust (the Trust). As part of your Team Registration, you are agreeing you have read and accepted the below CPSC 5v5 Soccer Competition Rules.

Team Registration payment of \$890 is to be made by credit card Online. Registrations must be completed online. Each participating player must be entered online (minimum of 5 registered players and maximum of 10 registered players per team will be accepted). Additional players can be added or removed throughout the season providing you do not exceed 10 registered players.

If your team is required to forfeit any matches, CPSC must be notified before 12pm on the day of the match by calling CPSC on (02) 9662 3526.

Failure to notify CPSC regarding your forfeiture or if CPSC is notified after 12pm on the day of the match, will result in your team will incurring a \$50 fine which is required to be paid at the CPSC Office before your next match. Failure to pay your forfeit fine prior to your next match will mean that your team will not be eligible to take the court until CPSC has received payment. Teams are to arrive at least 5-10 minutes prior to your game time and make themselves known to the soccer coordinator by the entrance of the soccer pitch.

If you are not on your pitch by the start of your scheduled match time, you may receive an automatic forfeit as we will assume you are not coming and organise another game for your opponents. If you are issued an automatic forfeit your team will incur a \$50 fine which is required to be paid at the CPSC Office before your next match.

Failure to pay your forfeit fine prior to your next match will mean your team will not be eligible to take the court until CPSC has received payment.

Please respect all referees and players.

Any disrespect or verbal abuse will not be tolerated. If there is any failure to adhere to these rules, the player or spectator will be asked to leave pitch and area. This could result in your team being removed from the competition with no refund.

Year 11 & 12 students are able to play, however if they under the age of 18 they must be accompanied by an adult at all games. You are able to interchange your registered players if you are short on numbers for a match. You may also contact CPSC on (02) 9662 3526 for assistance in finding extra players for you where possible.

Please ensure you do this within the timeframe allowed as otherwise you may be required to forfeit the match. CPSC will not guarantee finding any players. Decisions regarding extreme weather and cancellations are made each day at 5.30 pm. The coordinator will contact the captain of each team to advise of any cancellations.

Risk Warning -

Playing soccer is subject to risks and players can incur injuries. There are also risks that access to medical assistance, and evacuation might be slow; and of damage to, or loss of, your personal property

Release & Waiver -

If you suffer injury, loss, claims, liability or damage (Loss) while at Centennial Parklands Sports Centre, to the fullest extent permitted by law, you release the Trust and Clublinks Management Pty Ltd (Clublinks), their employees, officers and contractors from any liability for any Loss suffered by you and you release each of the Trust, Clublinks and their employees, officers and contractors from any responsibility or legal liability for death or personal injury associated with your presence at Centennial Parklands Sports Centre and any activities you undertake at Centennial Parklands Sports Centre.

Rule Handbook

Tournament rules are subject to change at the discretion of the Tournament Coordinator at any time during the course of the season.

Player Rules

Wear suitable footwear, soccer trainers or moulded cleats/boots, or astroturf trainers, are allowed, but no studs/soft ground cleats. No jewelry, no sliding or slide tackling, Shin guards mandatory. Show good sportsmanship at all times.

Team Rules

Where possible, teams should seek to have the same colour shirts/uniform, if not we will provide you with bibs to use on the night.

No foul language, or excessive shouting.

Minimum of 3 players required to start game \$50 penalty fee will be incurred if a team forfeits a game

Spectator Rules

No outside food or drink (other than water bottles) is allowed in the facility. No foul language, or vulgar chanting from fans. No smoking or alcoholic beverages on premises. Continuous verbal abuse to referee or league official will result in being banned from the sports centre. Spectators are responsible for children at all times

Scheduling

Games cannot be rescheduled or changed once the league schedule has been posted on centennial parklands sports centre website, or emailed to the captains. No exceptions!

Field Play

Dimensions – 40 meters x 30 meters. Ball size: Size 5. No offsides. Substitutions – On the fly.

All restarts are indirect (must touch another player on either team for a goal to be scored on restart), except penalty kicks and free kicks for handling. 12-week competitions are played on our state of the art all-weather fields, no games are called off due to wet weather. Games may only be called off in the event of extreme weather (e.g localized lightning) or urgent unplanned maintenance. Mixed Teams. There must always be at least 2 people from each sex on the field at all times.

Time

Game times: Run from 7pm, 7.40pm, and 8.20pm. Duration: 40 minutes. 2 x 19 minutes halves and 2 minutes halftime. All games are Running Time. Time kept on the field by referee (running time). There is a 2 minute break between games. Teams coming off must exit the field immediately. Teams coming on must be prepared to start the game immediately (no warm-up time or space designated on the game field). No overtime play. Games start promptly according to tournament schedule – no exceptions. Failure to field a team will result in a team forfeit. The clock runs from the designated game time, so if you are late to start the game or return from half time, your game time will be reduced as a result. There are spaces around the game pitches which you can warm up and cool down in, please ensure that your warm up/cool down does not affect the running of the competition (eg ball rolling onto game pitch)

Point System

Teams are awarded: 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, 0 points for a loss.

The tournament standings are determined by the following:
Total Team Points and then Grand Finals.





Tiebreakers

Head to Head Competition (not used if more than 2 teams tied with points). Most Wins - Goal Differential *All league games will be capped at a 5 goal maximum. Example: An 8-1 win will be recorded as 6-1. This is in place to avoid running up the score. - Goals For - Least Goals Against - Most Shutouts - Sudden Death PK's (at Tournament coordinators discretion)

If a team forfeits a game, the opposing team will be awarded with a win, five goals scored, and zero goals against.

Playoffs

If there is a tie in a playoff game, the game will go straight to penalty kicks. Three players from each team that are on the field at the end of regulation take a kick. - If score remains tied at the end of three kickers, one player from each team will shoot until a winner is decided.

Kick-off

The soccer ball will be placed in the center of the field, to start games and after goals are scored. Opposing team must stand 5 meters back from the kick off marker. - The ball can be played forward or backwards. No Goal: If the ball is kicked directly in on a kick-off.

Boundaries

No Kick-ins. Balls that go out of bounds will be played in by a Throw-In. Feet must be on the ground. In-bounding team has 5 seconds to get the ball in play. GOAL KICKS – When ball goes across the goal line, the goalkeeper must kick the ball from the penalty area within 10 seconds. In the case of an infraction of the 10 second rule, the opposing team will have an indirect kick from the midfield line. Corner kicks must be placed on designated line or between line and corner flag.

ONLINE Team Roster

A completed online team roster is due prior to the first scheduled game. Coaches may add or substitute players during the first 4 weeks the roster has been submitted. Players cannot play for another team in the same league. Player identification needs to be available in the case of the coordinator asking prior to each game or participant(s) may not play. Each team is allowed 10 players on the roster. Four field players and a goalkeeper consist of a team. A minimum of 3 players is needed to field a team. Less than 3 players result in an automatic team forfeit.

Team Bench & Substitutions

Team Bench

Players are responsible to clean up any garbage from their team bench.

Substitutions

- Unlimited substitutions. All players are substituted on the fly (rolling substitutions). Substituted players must first come off the field before a new player may enter. Violation of substitution rule will result in an indirect free kick for opposing team at the spot of the infraction (where substitute coming on early affects play). All substituting players and coaches must remain on team bench/area during the game. Coaches may not enter the field at any time unless the referee permits. Goalkeepers who are substituted must be differentiated with a different colored team shirt.

Fouls & Penalties

Two Yellow Cards during the same game = Player Ejection from Game.
Straight Red Card = Player Ejection from Game & Following League Game.





There will be Zero Tolerance for:

A player or coach who consistently argues with the referee. A player, coach or parent uses abusive language. A parent from a respective team does not comply with the parent acknowledgement form or argues with a referee and/or tournament administrator.

Free Kicks

All free kicks are indirect with the exception of penalty kicks and handling infractions. Indirect kick at midfield if goalkeeper throws the ball over the midfield line - Indirect kick from spot of infraction if goalkeeper handles a deliberate pass from their teammate. Indirect kick from spot of infraction if ball makes contact with lights of the facility. Indirect free kick if players slide or leave their feet.

Penalty Kicks

A penalty kick is awarded against a team that commits a FIFA direct kick foul inside the goal box. Penalty kicks are taken from the top center of the goal box. All players, except for the goalkeeper and the kicker, must stand behind midfield until the ball is kicked.

Forfeited Games

The forfeited team agrees to pay a \$50.00 penalty fee when his/her team forfeits a game. Failure to submit the \$50.00 penalty fee prior to the next scheduled game will result in the team's dismissal from the league. Additionally, the forfeited team will be penalized three (3) points from the league standings on top of the forfeited game. Teams who are 5 minutes late to their scheduled game will automatically forfeit their match. Teams who have less than the minimum number of players required at the start of match will forfeit their game. No rematches or make-ups will be awarded. If game is forfeited, the opposing team may utilize the time slot for team training or a game amongst themselves. No refunds of any kind are given once the team has registered in the league.

Sportsmanship

Players, coaches and spectators are expected to act in the nature of good sportsmanship at all times. - There will be no abuse (verbal or otherwise) of referees or league officials tolerated. Any indication of such behaviour by a coach or parent will result in immediate removal from Centennial Parkland Sports Centre. We are all here to play soccer and have fun!

Referees

The referees will have sole jurisdiction over the conduct of the game. - If a referee terminates a game for any reason, the score at the time of the termination will stand. - NO PROTESTS against Referees or League coordinators will be considered or allowed. If the League Rules appear to be violated, the matter may be brought to the attention of the League coordinator for the final resolution. - All decisions made by the League Coordinator will be final.

Inclement Weather

12-week competitions are played on our state of the art all-weather fields, no games are called off due to wet weather.

Dismissal from Tournament

The result of a coach, parent, or team fan involved in any type of physical confrontation or extreme verbal confrontation with other spectators, referees and/or league officials will automatically disqualify their entire team from the tournament with no refund. Centennial Parklands Rangers will be immediately called, as may the police. If not stated within this handbook, FIFA rules will apply to the league. Any questions regarding the rules of the league should be directed to a Centennial Parkland Sports Centre Official.
